Rabbi's Letter for February Bulletin By: Joel Baron

#### Subject: "Betweenness"

Here we sit in our annual calendar amidst the 30 days between Purim and Passover: in Hebrew *beyn Purim uveyn Pesach*; 30 days from the 14<sup>th</sup> of Adar until the 15<sup>th</sup> of Nissan. What a strange combination of holidays to sit between; what a wrenching transition in emotions. From a time of great joy to one that begins in great hardship.

The Talmud teaches, "with the beginning of Adar rejoicings are increased," and the Haggadah teaches, "this is the bread of affliction which our ancestors ate in the land of Egypt." Rejoicing is increased in Adar because it is the month of Purim, the holiday that celebrates "*upside-downness*" – we were supposed to be eradicated in a frenzy of genocide and behold Haman, the very one who would have done us in is done in himself! So we celebrate, not the demise of Haman, but the eradication of evil and the fact that we endured.

And in Egypt? There we were, barely enduring, and God heard our groaning and revealed Himself to Moses, who then brought God's message and release from bondage to these suffering Israelite slaves. And for the next 40-plus years, the slavery stopped, but life was still a struggle. And yet, we endured – as we still do.

On the one hand, a celebration for life sustained and evil eradicated; on the other hand, a remembrance of a life of hardship and slavery eradicated. *Beyn Purim uveyn Pesach*.

Yet we Jews actually *like* these situations of being betwixt and between. In Egypt we were told to hold onto a blemish-free lamb and then sacrifice it *between the evenings* on the 14<sup>th</sup> of Nissan; God's covenant with Abraham is called the *Covenant Between the Parts* because Abraham had to split each sacrifice in two. What does God do at Creation? First God creates heaven and earth, then light, and then immediately (Gen. 1:4) separates *between* light and darkness, and then *between* the waters above and the waters below, and then God separates Shabbat from the other six days of the week.

It is this sense of being able to live in that vague space that's *in between* from which we Jews have drawn such strength over the generations. There are Jews who come to synagogue twice a year, and there are Jews who *davven* three times a day – and both are Jews.

The same Jew who teaches the scientific theory of evolution on the one hand, can at the same time hold the Bible's story of Creation in the other hand. The same 2 million who walked through the desert for 40 years looking forward to the Promised Land also looked back at Egypt with an odd sort of nostalgia. Even our Passover Seder likes to remind us that on all other nights we have a choice between eating sitting up and reclining – *beyn yoshvin uveyn m'subin*.

So enjoy this time between our holidays. Look back at Purim and smile; look forward to Passover and consider the blessings of freedom. Don't choose, but embrace them both.

May your holidays and lives be filled with joy,




